

I assume you have uninstalled the imager I also assume you do not have Disk Director installed. If these conditions are true, you should get rid of snapman. However, If you're not willing to edit the registry, you are stuck with it.

There are only three registry edits needed to eliminate snapman:

1. HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\System\CurrentControlSet\Control\Class\{4D36E967-E325-11CE-BFC1-08002BE10318}

Remove snapman from the UpperFilters list on the right side.

2. HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\System\CurrentControlSet\Control\Class\{71A27CDD-812A-11D0-BEC7-08002BE2092F}

Remove snapman from the UpperFilters list on the right side.

3. HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\System\CurrentControlSet\Services\snapman

Delete the entire snapman key on the left side.

Now you can delete C:\Windows\System32\Drivers\snapman.sys.
